Tenor-saxophonist Matt Anderson graduated from Leeds College of Music's BA (Hons) Jazz degree course with First Class Honours, as well as being awarded the Sam Hood Rosebowl for Outstanding Performance (Jazz). Since graduating, he has been busy as a professional freelance musician working across the U.K., was awarded 'Young Musician of the Year' in the Jazz Yorkshire Awards 2010 and was named 'One to Watch' by the same organisation in 2013. In 2015 he released his debut album which was well received by critics and audiences alike and he currently resides in London.

Guitarist Alex Munk graduated from the masters programme at London's Royal Academy of Music with Distinction in 2011, where he was awarded the Elton John Scholarship, the Scott Philbrick Jazz Scholarship and the John Baker Memorial Prize, and since then his profile has grown steadily to the forefront of capital's fertile jazz scene. He performs in the bands of many highly regarded musicians and bandleaders in London and is also featured on many acclaimed contemporary recordings.
